### What can I do with a wiki?

- ~use as a tool for collaborative projects
- ~prepare students to write collaboratively in a networked environment
- ~easily contribute and edit
- ~easily monitor student progress and offer feedback
- ~observe the amount and quality of student contributions
- ~use to draft collaborative documents
- ~quickly create project resource pages
- ~host a poll
- ~use for classroom peer review exercises
- ~create a branching story
- ~use for student portfolios
- ~use to focus classroom discussions
- ~have younger students create dictionaries or vocabulary lists
- ~create cross-age collaborations across a school district
- ~create a study guide for each unit of a course
- ~collaborate with classes across the country or the world
